We will be starting a Virtual Sunday School Program that is being provided by NPH on the 13th of September.

The Christ Light Remote Learning program is a complete curriculum that combines teacher led lessons and engages parents in reinforcing the lessons in tangible ways with their children. Here are some specifics:

- ♦ NPH is producing Christ-Light Lesson Videos for grades PreK-K, 1-2, 3-4, and 5-6. The lessons for Sundays beginning September 13 will be recorded and taught by experienced WELS teachers and available via YouTube prior to each Sunday. The engaging and age-appropriate video-based lessons are free with no required password for access.
- ◆ Lesson Videos will include a brief introduction for parents along with the lesson's aim, the truth that is being shared, and a relevant application for the child, followed by the Bible lesson for the week.
- Printed Christ-Light Sunday School Student Lessons will be used by parents to help facilitate learning with their child.
- Following the Lesson Video, parents will be encouraged to complete an activity related to the lesson with their child and

- to reinforce the Memory Treasure.
- Printed Student Lessons are available for each grade level as noted above. They are shrink-wrapped in packs of 13 lessons for each student. The current cycle is Year 2, Fall, starting with Lesson 1, the story of God's creation of Adam and Eve.

We are asking parents to sign up their children after services on Sunday the 30th of August and the 9th of September. You can also contact Pastor at dsargentzambia@gmail.com or call 920-228-1061. Materials for the students will be ordered and paid for by the church. These will be made available to the parents on Sunday the 13 th of September.

Confirmation Class


We will begin confirmation class on Wednesday the 9th of September at 4:30. Please be reminded that student will be required to wear masks during class.

Search for our church by either typing the zip code (54157), typing "Ev. Lutheran Church of St. John, Grover, WI", or turn your locations on and "search for churches near me". With this method you can also help offset fees the church incurs for ACH transactions ONLY(bank routing) by clicking on the button "help offset" (first time setup transaction only).

ROMANS 11:13-15, 28-32
