

1 Love the Lord your God and always carry out his requirements, his statutes, his ordinances, and his commandments. 2 Know this today! I am not addressing your children, who have not known and seen all these things: the discipline of the Lord your God; his greatness, his strong hand, and his outstretched arm; 3 his signs and his deeds that he performed in Egypt against Pharaoh king of Egypt and against all his land; 4 what he did to the army of Egypt and its horses and chariots; how he caused the water of the Red Sea to flow over their heads when they pursued you; how the Lord has destroyed them to this day; 5 what he did for you in the wilderness until you came to this place; 6 what he did to Dathan and Abiram, the sons of Eliab son of Reuben; how the earth opened its mouth and swallowed them with their households, their tents, and every living thing that was at their feet, in the middle of all Israel. 7 Know today it is your own eyes that have seen every deed that the Lord your God performed. 26 You see, I am placing before you today a blessing and a curse: 27 the blessing, if you listen to the commandments of the Lord your God that I am giving you today, 28 or the curse, if you do not listen to the commandments of the Lord your God and you turn away from the path that I am commanding you today by walking after other gods whom you did not know.

PSALM OF THE DAY SECOND LESSON

PSALM 33 (PAGE 79) GALATIANS 5:13-25

13 After all, brothers, you were called to freedom. Only do not use your freedom as a starting point for your sinful flesh. Rather, serve one another through love. 14 In fact, the whole law is summed up in this one statement: "Love your neighbor as your-

self." 15 But if you keep on biting and devouring one another, watch out that you are not consumed by one another. 16 What I am saying is this: Walk by the spirit, and you will not carry out what the sinful flesh desires. 17 For the sinful flesh desires what is contrary to the spirit, and the spirit what is contrary to the sinful flesh. In fact, these two continually oppose one another, so that you do not continue to do these things you want to do. 18 But if you are led by the spirit, you are not under the control of the law. 19 Now the works of the sinful flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity, complete lack of restraint, 20 idolatry, sorcery, hatred, discord, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambition, dissensions, heresies, 21 envy, murders, drunkenness, orgies, and things similar to these. I warn you, just as I also warned you before, that those who continue to do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. 22 But the fruit of the spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, and self-control. Against such things there is no law. 24 Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the sinful flesh with its passions and desires. 25 If we live by the spirit, let us also walk in step with it.

VERSE OF THE DAY Alleluia. Because we are his children, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" Alleluia. (Galatians 4:6)

GOSPEL LUKE 4:16-21

16 He went to Nazareth, where he had been brought up. As was his custom, he went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day and stood up to read. 17 The scroll of the prophet Isaiah was handed to him. He unrolled the scroll and found the place where it was written: 18 The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he anointed

me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set free those who are oppressed, 19 and to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor. 20 He rolled up the scroll, gave it back to the attendant, and sat down. The eyes of everyone in the synagogue were fastened on him. 21 He began to tell them, "Today, this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."

SERMON TEXT PSALM 33:12-22

12 How blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord, the people he chose to be his possession. 13From heaven the Lord observes. He sees all the children of Adam. 14 From his throne room he looks at all the inhabitants of earth. 15 He alone is the one who shapes all their hearts. He understands all their deeds. 16 No king is saved by the great size of his army. No hero is rescued by his great strength. 17 You cannot rely on a horse to save you. Its great strength will not deliver you. 18 Look, the eye of the Lord is on those who fear him, on those who wait for his mercy. 19 He will deliver their souls from death. He keeps them alive in famine. 20 Our souls wait for the Lord. He is our help and our shield. 21 Yes, in him our heart rejoices, because we trust in his holy name. 22 May your mercy, O Lord, be on us, even as we wait confidently for you.
