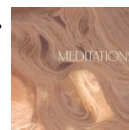
**Disaster Relief Door Offering** A sincere **“THANK YOU”** to all that contributed towards the “Disaster Relief Door Offering”.

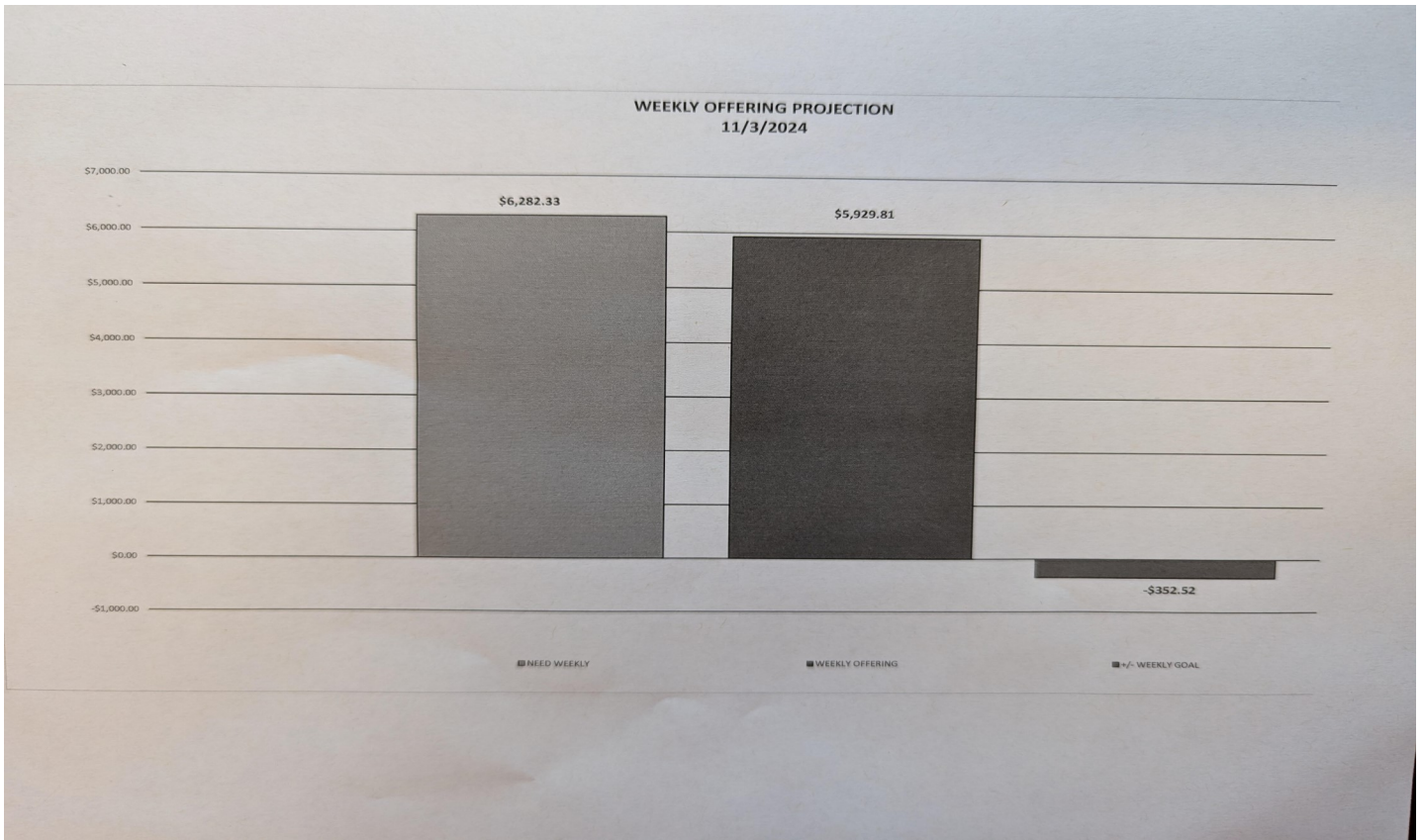

**FIRST LESSON****MALACHI 4:1-2A**

Look! The day is coming, burning like a blast furnace. All the arrogant and every evildoer will be stubble. The day that is coming will set them on fire, says the Lord of Armies, a day that will not leave behind a root or branch for them. 2 But for you who fear my name, the sun of righteousness will rise, and there will be healing in its wings.

**PSALM OF THE DAY****PSALM 90, PAGE 99****SECOND LESSON****HEBREWS 9:24-28**

24 For Christ did not enter a handmade sanctuary, a representation of the true sanctuary. Instead, he entered into heaven itself, now to appear before God on our behalf. 25 And he did not enter to offer himself many times, as the high priest enters the Most Holy Place year after year with blood that is not his own. 26 Otherwise he would have needed to suffer many times since the creation of the world. But now he has appeared once and for all, at the climax of the ages, in order to take away sin by the sacrifice of himself. 27 And, just as it is appointed for people to die only once and after this comes the judgment, 28 so also Christ was offered only once to take away the sins of many, and he will appear a second time—without sin—to bring salvation to those who are eagerly waiting for him.

**VERSE OF THE DAY** Alleluia. Watch therefore, for you do not know on what day your Lord is coming. Alleluia.

(Matthew 24:42 RSV)

**GOSPEL****JOHN 5:19-24**

19 Jesus answered them directly, "Amen, Amen, I tell you: The Son can do nothing on his own, but only what he sees the Fa-

ther doing. Indeed, the Son does exactly what the Father does. 20 For the Father loves the Son and shows him everything he is doing. And he will show him even greater works than these so that you will be amazed. 21 For just as the Father raises the dead and gives them life, so also the Son gives life to those he wishes. 22 “In fact, the Father judges no one, but has entrusted all judgment to the Son, 23 so that all should honor the Son just as they honor the Father. Whoever does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent him. 24 Amen, Amen, I tell you: Anyone who hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He is not going to come into judgment but has crossed over from death to life.
