
## Grade 1 & 2 News

## Grade 1 Spelling List:

In first grade the students are starting Unit 3 in reading class. This week we will learn about the sound "ng" makes - as in "king" and "long." The new spelling list has this letter pattern in all the words. Our next spelling test will be on **Friday**, October 24.

**Second Grade** is learning about words that have the "-ed" ending this week. Their list of words has some Memory Words mixed in as well. Their next test is on **Friday, October 24.** 

As we approach the end of the first quarter, our students will be taking two MAP tests, one in reading and one in math. These are standardized tests that students take on the computer. The students will use headphones and a Chromebook to take the tests. At this grade level, students will have all their questions read to

them and they will be picking an answer. This first test will give me a baseline of where each child is starting and will help inform my lesson planning to best meet each student's needs. Students will have a total of three MAP test sessions this year, so we look forward to seeing their growth as the year progresses.
