
Grade 1 & 2 News

December 8, 2025

This week we are studying how God directed the Israelites to live and worship. Our **first graders** are starting a new reading unit, and we are introducing long vowels this week. This is a big step for our first graders because up until now we have only been using the short vowel sound as we sound out words. Any long vowel words we encountered were considered "Memory Words." Now the students will learn the second major sound that each of the vowels can make and rules about when to use a long vowel sound instead of a short vowel sound as they are reading. **Their spelling test will be on Friday, 12/12/25.**

Second graders are learning about the hard and soft c and g sounds this week. We are also reading a chapter book together called, "The Bears on Hemlock Mountain." The next spelling test will be on Friday, 12/12/25.
