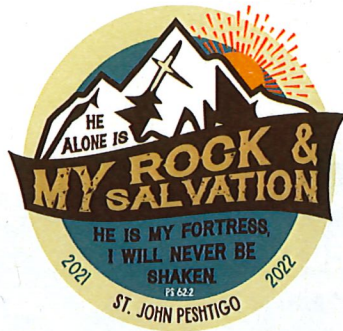

Hot Lunch

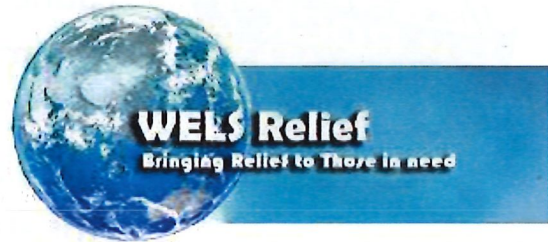

Pastor's Report

- **Mrs. Aguilar** - 13 students. One 3rd grader, seven 4th graders and five 5th graders. New routine with math rotations and doing a new writing program. She and Mr. Aguilar has been switching, she is doing music and art and he is doing physical education.
