**Please bring these supplies to school on Registration Night, August 7th!**

- ☐ Wood\* or mechanical pencils\*\* (**Enough to last the school year**)
- ☐ Large eraser x2
- ☐ Scissors
- ☐ (4) glue sticks
- ☐ (2) box of standard 24 crayons
- ☐ (2) box of 10-12 colored pencils
- ☐ (2) box of 10-12 regular tip markers (not thin tip)
- ☐ (2) bottles of liquid glue (4 oz.)
- ☐ (2) **black** Expo dry-erase markers, regular/chisel tip
- ☐ (1) Ruler (inches and centimeters), stiff and **not bendable**
- ☐ (1) plastic pencil box
- ☐ (1) pack of around 100 sticky notes (3in. x 3in.)
- ☐ (3) Spiral bound single subject wide ruled notebooks: 1 blue(4th and 5th grade only), 1 green , 1 red
- ☐ 1 Composition notebook (For daily journaling)
- ☐ (4) 2 pocket folders: 1 blue (4th and 5th grade only), 1 green, 2 choice (choice folders need to be durable, as one will be their home folder)
- ☐ Water Bottle
- ☐ Headphones
- ☐ Outside shoes
- ☐ (4) large boxes of tissues
- ☐ Last names **A-K** 100 spoons, **L-R**: 150 plates, **S-Z**: 100 forks
- ☐ Bible (for new students/3rd graders, will be provided by school)
- ☐ Hymnal (for new students/ 3rd graders, will be provided by school)

**\*Some wood pencils have their colors and design as plastic wrap that can be removed. This plastic wrap gets stuck in pencil sharpeners. Please avoid these pencils.**

**\*\*Keep in mind that mechanical pencils are an extra level of responsibility. The student must be able to fill and keep track of their small pieces of lead.**
