The class has done two recordings in church and the kids are doing very well at memorizing for these recordings. Kids are also enjoying the ability to be outside more. They are starting a new science curriculum, more hands on and the kids seem to be enjoying this as well. They have also seen good progression in the math levels of the students, catching up from the time off last year.

Old Business:

End of Year Picnic: CEA asked for dollars to be used towards end of year picnic. \$175 approved by Kim page, second by Brian Olson.

Other Business:

Gaga Ball Pit Mat: we will be looking to fix the drainage of the pit instead of purchasing a mat for the pit. Cody Maedke and volunteers will dig it out add drainage materials, felt and a covering of sort to help the situation.

Mulch: Cody Maedke will have this hauled in and asks that anyone who is willing to help with this project consider coming to help on Saturday April 24 at 9:00. This is church clean-up day. There are also some

repairs and upkeep items needed for the playground equipment that will be done that day. Anyone able to help is asked to bring rakes and shovels. Many hands make light work. Asked CEA to approve \$250 for the mulch. Becky Rhode approved, Jenny Thompson 2nd all in favor.

Mask Wearing Discussion: Open discussion was had. Asked for support to continue to wear masks until May 3. At that, time would go to personal decision. Form was sent home for families to complete if they feel they would like to. Teachers indicated they would continue to wear masks to help support those students/families that wish to continue to wear them until the end of the school year.
