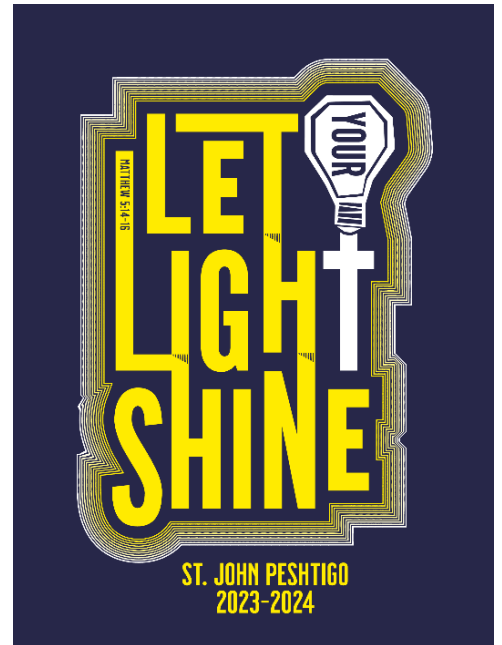
Kindergarteners are learning about the letter Ee and Superkid Ettabetta. She loves toys, games, and puzzles.
