We have now begun learning about the time of the Judges during our Christ-light lessons. The first Judge we are going to study is Gideon. Gideon lived during a time of trouble for the Israelites. They had settled in Canaan but were horribly influenced by their neighbors. The Israelites became lax in their attentiveness to God's Word and had let idol worship penetrate their lives. Gideon's own father worshiped idols. God's anger burned against the Israelites, and he allowed their enemies to invade and cause a lot of trouble for them. In their troubles, Israel cried out to the Lord for help, and the Lord chose Gideon to lead them. As a judge, Gideon led the Israelites both spiritually and in battle. Our Lord showed mercy to the Israelites when they asked for help, just as he shows mercy to us.

Let's learn from the mistakes of the Israelites and avoid all things that would pull us away from God. **Let's hold tightly to the Word of the Lord, studying it in our homes, in Bible classes, and at church. It is only through the Scriptures that we have the Words for everlasting life.**
