
Mrs. Myslik's K-1 News and Notes

Welcome back to school! I am very excited to begin our school year! This year we will be learning so many wonderful things in our room! This week we will have hot lunch on Friday. The hot lunch meal is spaghetti. Anyone who would like to have hot lunch should bring \$2 and give it to me in the morning. If your child is not interested in having hot lunch, that is fine, just please make sure to send a cold lunch.

Each Tuesday and Thursday afternoon the kindergarteners are spending some time with Mrs. Rohde in her classroom to do creative play, recess, and table activities. During this time they will also have a snack. As you are packing your child's lunch, please keep this in mind. I will encourage them to reserve something in their lunch bag that they can have for their afternoon snack, too.
