No School: Remember we have a short week since there is no school on Thursday and Friday. During these two days the teachers are going to the Wisconsin State Lutheran Teachers' Conference in Milwaukee.

Area Reformation Service – There is a special Reformation Worship Service on Sunday, October 30. It will be held at one of our sister Lutheran churches - Trinity Lutheran Church in Coleman (221 N. Louis Ave. Coleman, WI). The service starts at 4:00 and there will be a pot luck with chicken dinner following the service. Our school children have been invited to participate in the service by singing a song we learned last year (Oh Lord, My Rock and My Redeemer). We sent home a note about the service last week and asked parents to sign and return the letter indicating if you would be coming and if your child will be singing. **Please be sure to return the bottom portion of the note so we can let Pastor Langebartels how many of our students and their families they can expect to come.**

Kindergarten – In Kindergarten reading we have just finished learning about Superkid, Doc. This week we are starting to learn all about our next Superkid, Sal! Sal is a fun guy who loves all sports. This is such an exciting time for Kinder reading...they are starting to sound out real words all on their own! Using the letters c, o, g, a, and d the students can sound out and read words like God, dog, odd, add, and Doc. Yay!!!

Our **first graders** are learning about the “-consonant+le” words this week. This refers to words that end with a consonant followed by the letters le. Their spelling list includes this pattern for four of the words, the rest are memory words that were introduced to the children last week. This week the children will also read a fun story that the Superkids make up one person at a time.

Since we won't be having school on Thursday and Friday our **next spelling test will be pushed off to the following week - Tuesday, November 1.**

Second Grade will start unit 4 in reading class this week. Their spelling words focus on r-controlled vowels, which can be very tricky since the er, ir, and ur all sound the same. **Their next spelling test will be Tuesday, November 1.**

Costume Parade -- I am inviting the children to come **dressed in costumes on Monday, October 31.** So, let's see those fun costumes! Please make sure there are no "scary, horror, or gore" costumes...we want this to be a fun day, not one that will give others nightmares! (Thanks for your understanding!)

Since we do not have school on Friday, there is no hot lunch this week.

The end of the first quarter is on Wednesday. It's hard to believe we've been in school that long already! Report cards will be going home on Wednesday, November 2. Along with that, we will have **Parent/Teacher Consultations on November 3.** Teachers will be meeting with parents **Thursday from 3:00-8:00p.m.** You can sign up for a meeting time using Sign-up Genius on our school's website. This is a quick (15-20 minute) meeting for parents and teachers to get together and discuss each child's progress so far. Children are not expected to come along for this visit, and if work schedules make it difficult for both parents to come, that is very understandable...one parent is fine.
