From now until Easter we are studying the events of the Passion History during our Christ-light lessons. Kindergarteners This week the kindergarteners are learning about the letter Pp and reading a story about the Superkids going on a picnic.

Our **first graders** are starting a new unit this week which focuses on the r-controlled vowels. First we will look at "ar" and "or" words. The next spelling test is on **Friday, April 4.** We will also read a fun story about a slumber party.

New this week: Each of the students in K-1 will have a speaking part in our play. The children are all getting a copy of the lines they need to learn. Please practice the lines with your child so they can say them easily by the end of this week. The children in kindergarten are paired up with another student to say their line together. The first graders will get to speak 2 times, once by themselves and once with a friend. **Look in your child's folder for a copy of their lines so they can practice.**

Practices: Next week (April 7, 8, and 10) we will have 3 after-school

practices so we can get used to being on the stage and speaking into the microphone. We will have regular school days, then at the end of the day the Peshtigo bus will transport all the children to the school. Once the practice is done parents will need to pick up their children from St. Thomas Aquinas. Practices will be on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday.
