In Christ-light this week we are learning about Jesus going to the temple with Mary and Joseph. As we study this lesson we see how important the Scriptures are to Jesus, and how perfectly he obeyed the law for us. Our second lesson this week is about John the Baptist beginning his ministry of getting people ready for the Savior. **May we follow Jesus' example and put the Lord's Word first in our lives.**

We are learning a song called, "His Mercy Is More" – which is also the theme of our school year. Last Friday the children said verse 2 to me for memory work. This week we are learning the words for verse 3. In Kindergarten Reading we are just finishing the "Oo" book and they will be coming home this week. Go through the book with your child and ask questions about what they are learning. We learned about a Superkid named Oswald who loves odd animals. Our newest Superkid is actually not a kid at all! It is a Super dog named Golly. Golly loves to sniff things – especially stinky garbage!

In first grade we just started our first unit in our new book, Adventures of the Superkids. This is a hardcover book paired with a soft cover workbook. This coming week we will read our first story from the hardcover book called, "A Patch in a Pinch." Superkid Sal has a major problem with his pants and needs a friend's help!
