Memory Work - Some kids are really doing an excellent job learning and saying their memory work. Keep up the good work! Some children are having a hard time remembering to learn their Bible passage. Please make sure to keep the yellow calendar handy and practice the Bible passage often at home. Children are expected to practice their passage at home, know it well, and say it to me when they come to school. If you need a new copy, you can download one from the school website, or ask me for a new one.

Field Trip: Our first field trip will be on **October 5**. This is a combined trip with Mrs. Rohde’s 4K class and our K-2 room. We will be going to Badger Park in Peshtigo for some outside fun and an early picnic lunch. After we finish lunch we will load our bus and drive to BerryLand in Abrams for some outdoor fall fun which will include picking out a pumpkin from the pumpkin patch. If you are coming and want to take a pumpkin home, you can purchase one right at the pumpkin farm directly. The school will cover the admission fee for the children in our classroom, additional children (like a younger sibling) are \$7. Children who are younger than 4 years old can’t ride on the bus, so if you are planning to come along and wish to bring a younger sibling you will have to drive separately so the little ones are able to be in their car seat. Please have your child dressed for the weather, and wear their school theme t-shirts on the field trip.

Our **first graders** are learning about the sh sound this week. Their spelling list will include four Pattern Words with the sh sound and six Memory Words that we have been working on since last week. This week’s Memory Words are all pronouns. **Their next spelling test is on Friday, September 30.**

Second Grade is starting Reading Unit 2 this week. An exciting part of the week is that we will be reading a novel together as part of our reading class. Our first novel is called “Mercy Watson Fights Crime.” It is a fun, silly story about a pig that accidentally stops a robbery. I think the class will enjoy it. **The next spelling test is on Friday, September 30.** During spelling activities we are reviewing the “consonant-le” letter pattern and the -ng pattern. Along with pattern words we have some memory words to learn. The list is coming home today for students to use for practice.
