In the week ahead we are learning about **The Flood** and **The Tower of Babel**. Both lessons focus on God's power over the world. What a great lesson for us to remember. Our loving Lord has complete control over all things and works out everything for the good of his people.

I sent home a "Memory Work Calendar" with all the students the last week of August. On the back of the calendar is a sheet that has the Bible passages

written out and the words for songs we will be singing in church. Please make sure to practice the memory work with your child(ren) at home. While the second graders are able to read most of the words and are able to learn their passages somewhat independently, the kindergarteners and first graders really need more help and practice with mom and dad. Our Scholastic book order will be finalized after school today. If you still want to order books for your child, let me know and I will hold the order until I receive yours. The books should be coming in either at the end of this week or early next week.

The kindergarteners have just finished our first letter book. It is all about a Superkid named Cass. Cass loves to cook, has a cat named Coconut, and likes to make crazy food concoctions. The kindergarteners are doing a great job learning and practicing the letter c! Next we will start learning about the letter o and a new Superkid named Oswald. This Superkid loves learning about odd animals like the ostrich, an ocelot, the octopus, and otters.

In reading, the first graders are continuing to review the letters of the alphabet and the memory words they learned last school year. This week they will be getting a list of spelling words to practice at home. At the end of the week – this Friday – they will be given their **first spelling test**. You can help your child prepare for the test by reviewing the list every day and have them write each word at home. The first graders will have a new spelling list to work on every five lessons and will have a test on the fifth lesson day.

Our second graders have finished going through a review book called, <u>Good-bye Summer!</u> Today we are starting our first unit with our hard cover books. Their next spelling test will be on Friday. Their list is coming home today. Second graders will have a spelling test every five lessons, as opposed to every unit like
