

Notes and News from Mrs. Myslik's K-2s

September 20, 2021

In the week ahead we are learning about Abraham. These lessons focus on God's faithfulness to his promises to Abraham and the wonderful example of trust Abraham places in our Lord.

The theme t-shirts are coming home today! Please have your child wear it for **field trips**, for **the Peshtigo Historical Days Parade on September 25**, and when **we sing in church on October 3**. If you ordered and did not

receive a t-shirt, please let me know asap so we can look into it and get it figured out.

Mark your calendars for **Saturday, September 25.** This is when our school will participate in the **Peshtigo Historical Days Parade**. We will have a float and we are looking for people to walk along with the float to pass out candy from our school. If you are interested in helping out, please contact Pastor Sargent. Our spot in the parade is Line number 2, unit 23. Please bring your child to our parade spot by 10:15am so we are all assembled and ready for the parade to start at 10:30. The parade ends at Badger Park. Please make arrangements to meet your child at the end of the parade route. Any parents of prek-2nd grade students who wish to ride the float with their child are welcome to do so. **Don't forget to dress your child for the weather, and wear your theme t-shirts!**

Kindergarten Reading - The kindergarteners have been learning about a boy named Oswald, and he likes odd animals. We learned about the special starting spot that c has last week - just below the top line – then we make these letters by going up and around in a smooth line. The letter o **starts in the same spot**. When you see your child drawing circles, always encourage them to use the special starting spot that we learned about. (This will help them with correctly writing MANY of our other letters in the future.)

First Grade Reading/Spelling - In reading, the first graders are done with their review unit and are now starting on learning new letter combinations. This week we are learning about the sh and ch sounds. The new spelling list is coming home today and we will have their next spelling test on Friday. You can help your child prepare for the test by reviewing the list every day and have them write each word at home. The first graders will have a new spelling list to work on every five lessons and will have a test on the fifth lesson day.

Second Grade Reading/Spelling – This week the second graders are going to spend a lot of time with question words along with decoding and encoding words with the wh and th sounds. Our next spelling test will be on Friday. We are also spending time reading a magazine called "Super!" which is part of our reading series. There are great articles in it about a wide variety of interesting things. This week we will read about making inventions and the inventor Leonardo DaVinci.
