

Notes and News from Mrs. Myslik's K-2s November 29, 2021

During Christ-light this week we are learning about the life of Moses and the Children of Israel. Last week we learned about the early life of Moses and how God used Pharaoh's own daughter to rescue him from certain death in the Nile River. This week we will see how God teaches Moses to rely on him and how God called Moses to be the leader of the Children of Israel.

To prepare for the Children's Christmas Eve Service, our school children and Sunday School students have combined practices three Saturdays in December. Please plan to bring your child(ren) to these practices from **9:00-11:00 on December 4, 11, and 18.**

Kindergarteners have finished their L books and are now learning about the letter I and Superkid Icky (short for Ichabod). Icky loves shows of all kinds. Watching them and pretending to be on them. Notice we are learning another vowel. So far we have learned the vowels o, a, and i. Now the kindergarteners are able to sound out so many words! Keep practicing words at home as you

read with your child. The more they practice and enjoy stories with you, the better readers they will become!

Our **first graders** are working on adding -ed and -ing endings onto words. They have been taught the rule that if the base word has one vowel, followed by one consonant, the consonant has to be doubled before adding the ending. We call this the "one-one rule." Our book uses a blue star next to the rule as we practiced it and were introduced to it. So sometimes we refer to the "blue star" rule, too. The new spelling list is coming home today and the test will be on Friday. The list has six memory words as well. Be sure to practice these words every day!

Second Grade is learning about the sound the letters oo and ew make. Their spelling list focuses on these letter combinations. The next test will be on Friday, December 3.

Cold weather is coming! Please consider checking to make sure your child has what they need for winter weather outside gear. It is not a requirement, just something some parents do so their child doesn't have to haul them back and forth every day.

On Wednesday, December 22, we are having our classroom Christmas party. During the party we will have a gift exchange. Please try to keep the gift cost around \$5. Girls should bring a gift appropriate for a girl, and boys for a boy. Just mark the tag, "For a boy" or "For a girl" and who it is from. We will be playing a game to decide who will be getting each present. We will be putting our tree up in our classroom next week, so children can bring their gifts for the exchange after December 13. Please make sure your child's gift for the exchange is here by Monday, Dec. 20.

If any parents would like to help with our Christmas party, I would welcome the help! I'm looking for people to help plan 2-3 games for the children and make a craft (or two if they are quick). We'll be starting our party after lunch recess, about 12:40, and go to the end of the day (2:55). If you are able to help out please let me know via email or a note. Thanks!!
