During Christ-light this week we are learning about the first Passover. That time when God sent the final plague to the Egyptians, and the Angel of the Lord passed over all the homes that had the blood of a lamb painted on their doorframes. What an amazing picture of our Savior this is! During Advent we learn about John the Baptist pointing out our Savior Jesus and declaring, "Look, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin
