

## What's the Buzz in K-2? 2/13/23

In Christ-light this week we are learning about a number of lessons Jesus taught. We are starting with "Giving Taxes to Caesar" and "The Widow's Offering." Both of these lessons talk about how we should use our gifts of money. In the taxes to Caesar lesson Jesus responded to a verbal trap the Pharisees laid for him when they asked if it was right to pay taxes. Jesus calmly said to give to the government what is owed to them and not to neglect our

offerings to the Lord. In our second lesson this week, "The Widow's Offering," Jesus points out that the woman in the temple was giving a very generous offering, because in faith she gave all she had to the Lord. What a great example of joyful giving!

**Kindergarteners** are learning about the letter Bb this week. One of the things we will focus on this week is learning to distinguish between the letter b and the letter d. It is common for children to mix up these two letters, which is why we learned the letter d early in the year and the letter b just now. If you see your child struggling with this, remind them that the letter d starts in our special starting spot and goes around, up, and down. The letter b starts at the top and bounces like a ball down and around.

Our **first graders** are learning about the letter y this week, and how it can take on the sound of long i if there is no other vowel in the word. They will also learn that y at the end of a word says the long e sound if there is another vowel in the word that is not right next to the y. Their spelling test will be on **Friday, February 17.** 

**Second Grade** is learning about a few irregular ways to spell the long e sound: ey, ie, and ine. Their spelling test will be on **Friday, February 17.**
