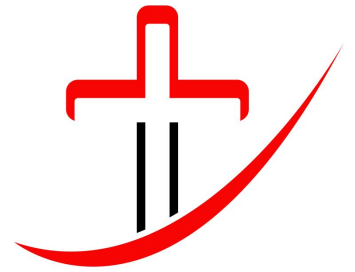

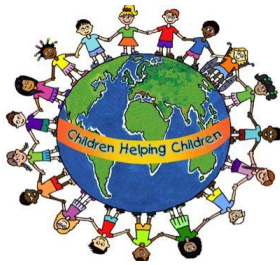
### CEA Target Ball Toss

### **Winter Weather Closings and Delays**

Even though we had such beautiful weather last week, it's getting to be that time of year when we need to think about inclement weather. In case of any winter weather school closings or delays, please note the following:

1. St. John follows the closings of both the Peshtigo and Coleman School Districts because of busing.
2. If both school districts are closed, St. John is also closed.
3. If the Peshtigo school district is closed, but Coleman is not, St. John IS closed.
4. If the Coleman school district is closed, but Peshtigo is not, St. John IS closed.
5. If either of the districts is delayed, St. John is also delayed.
