

Just a reminder that the open enrollment period to apply for the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP) begins Monday, February 1 and goes through Thursday, April 15. Parents intending to apply for the 2021-22 school year need to go to the WI Department of Public Instruction (DPI) web page in order to complete an application. An email address is required in order to use the system.
