

Health Update

We have had a few suspected cases of hand, foot, and mouth disease in our school. In response to this, we will be conducting daily cleaning in the affected classrooms and the restrooms. We will continue to follow our policy of asking students to stay home if they have a fever of 100 degrees or higher. If the student feels well enough to learn at school, they may come back when they have been fever-free without medication for 24 hours. The best response we can have to mitigate the spread of this illness is proper hand-washing techniques, which we will stress in the classroom. We have consulted with local public health officials and are following their guidelines. We are committed to maintaining a safe and healthy learning environment for your children.
