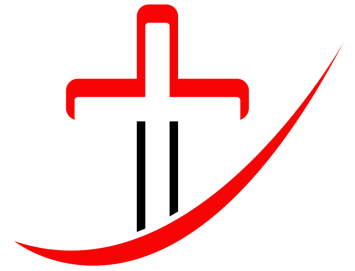
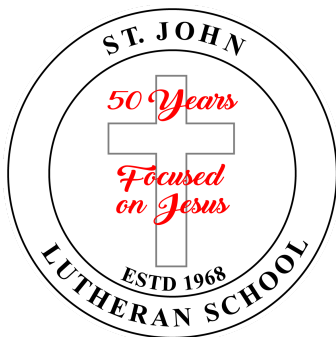

Today is National Chocolate Cupcake Day!
Cupcakes can be traced back to 1796 when there was a recipe notation of “a cake to be baked in small cups” written in *American Cookery*, by Amelia Simmons.

- Chocolate comes from a fruit tree; it’s made from a seed.
- It takes 400 cocoa beans to make one pound of chocolate.
- Each cacao tree produces approximately 2,500 beans.
- A farmer must wait four to five years for a cacao tree to produce its first beans.
