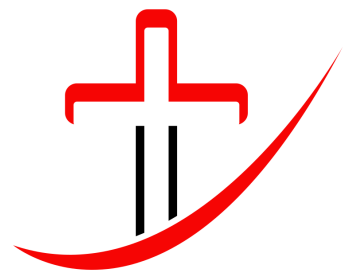

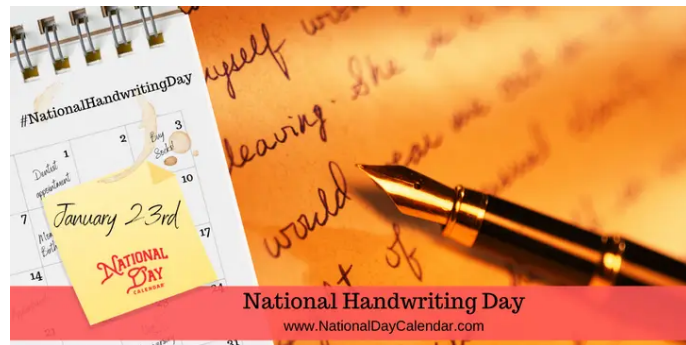
### Singing in Church
