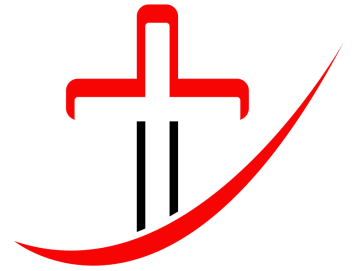
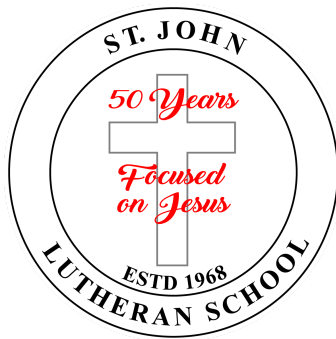

6-8 - Chocoholics

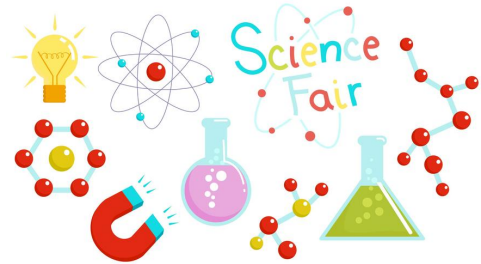
We really appreciate families contributing at least one item to their child's classroom basket.

If families would like to donate their own baskets or items to the bucket raffle that would be amazing! If you would like to donate a basket you can drop it off at school anytime before Entertainment Night.

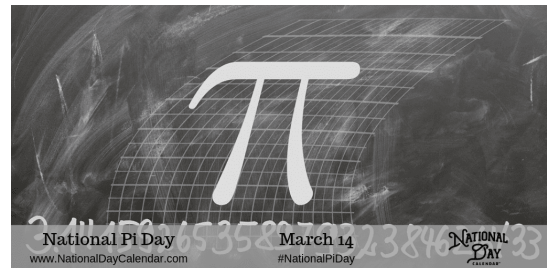
## Science Fair
