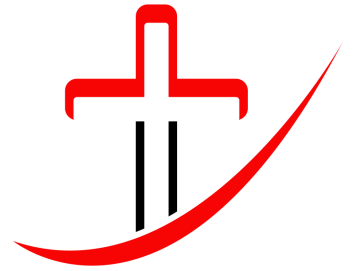
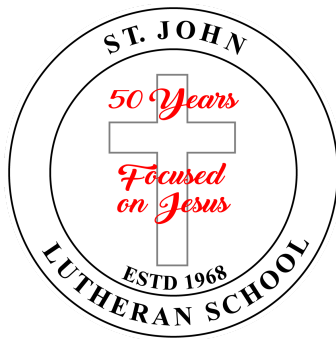

6-8 - Chocoholics

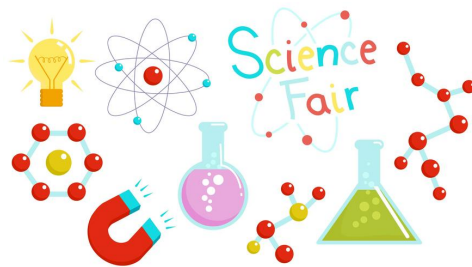


We really appreciate families contributing at least one item to their child's classroom basket.
