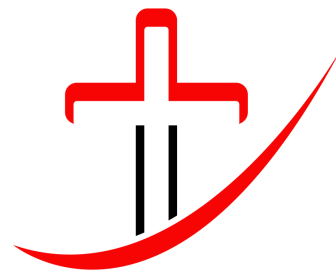
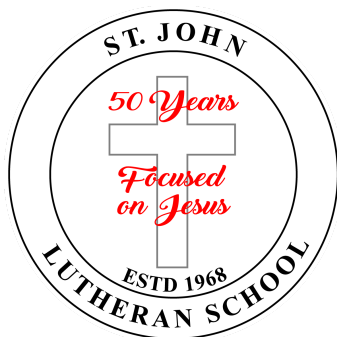

## Softball

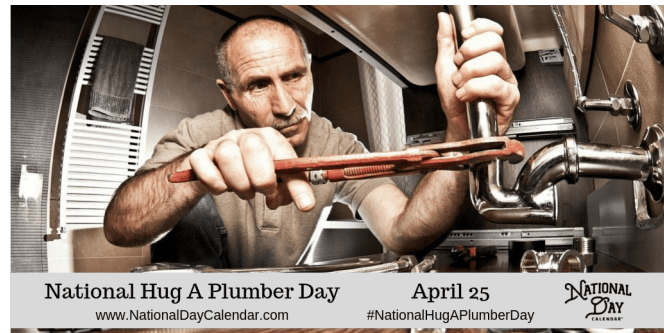
