Today is National Shamu the Whale Day! Shamu is the name that is used in several of the SeaWorld orca whale shows. It is the stage name that is given to the "star" of those shows, beginning with the original Shamu in the late 1960s. Shamu died in 1971. However, SeaWorld



trademarked the name Shamu. They gave the name to different orcas throughout the years when performing in Shamu shows in several SeaWorld parks.

Did you know?

- Orcas weigh up to 6 tons and grow to 23 to 32 feet. That is almost as long as a school bus.
- One study found a group of orcas traveling all the way from the waters off of Alaska to those near central California. This is a distance of more than 1,200 miles!
- Orcas are very social and live in groups called pods, which usually have up to 40 members.
- Orcas are apex predators, at the top of the food chain. No other animals hunt orcas.
