Now that we are back in the swing of school again, I just wanted to mention a few things that are coming up.

Family Entertainment Night is April 19! The big event we have in just a week and a half is Family Entertainment Night on April 19. This year we are renting a space with a stage from St. Thomas Aquinas School in the city of Peshtigo.

I gave each child a part to play in our musical. They received a piece of paper with their lines on it. Most children in kindergarten have 2 lines to say that rhyme. The children in first grade have a little bit more. Please help your child to learn their lines so they can say them - on their own - the best they can. With all the days off last week, we really need to push extra hard to practice every day!

Practices: Next week we will have 3 after-school practices so we can get used to being on the stage and speaking into the microphone. We will have regular school days, then at the end of the day the Peshtigo bus will transport all the children to the school. Once the practice is done parents will need to pick up their children from St. Thomas Aquinas. Practices will be on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday. Our classroom will practice first and the older grades will practice after we are done. For the children who have to stay until their older sibling is finished with practice (at 4:30), you may want to send an extra snack to have while they wait. Costumes: This year our class is doing a garden themed musical for Family Entertainment Night. Each child will be a kind of a food or a farmer. I have purchased colored t-shirts for the main part of each child's costume, but families will need to supply the pants or leggings to go with their costume. All of the kids who are a food item can wear black or navy blue leggings or jeans and a pair of good fitting tennis shoes. The children who are our farmers (Jonah and Addy) should wear jeans or overalls, a plaid shirt, a hat, and a pair of good fitting tennis shoes.

On Family Entertainment Night we do drawings for different prizes and baskets. It is a major fund raiser for our school and has allowed us to put in new flooring in two classrooms already, and we are hoping to raise enough money for a third classroom this coming year.
