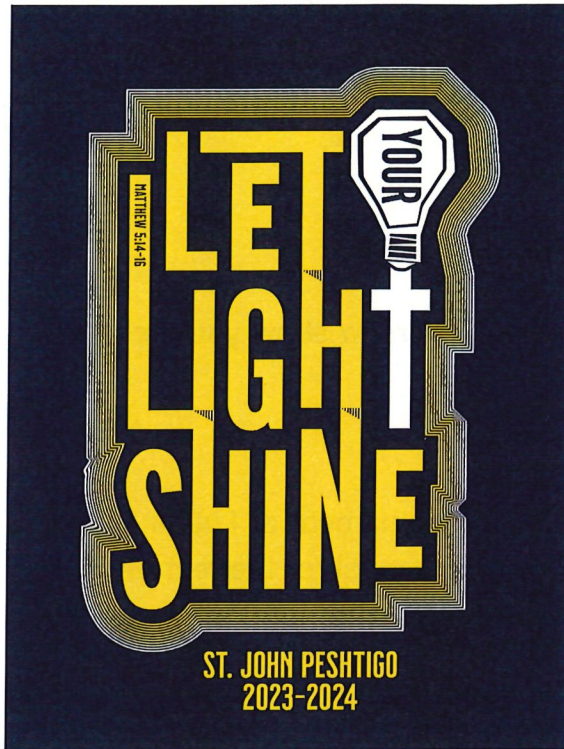

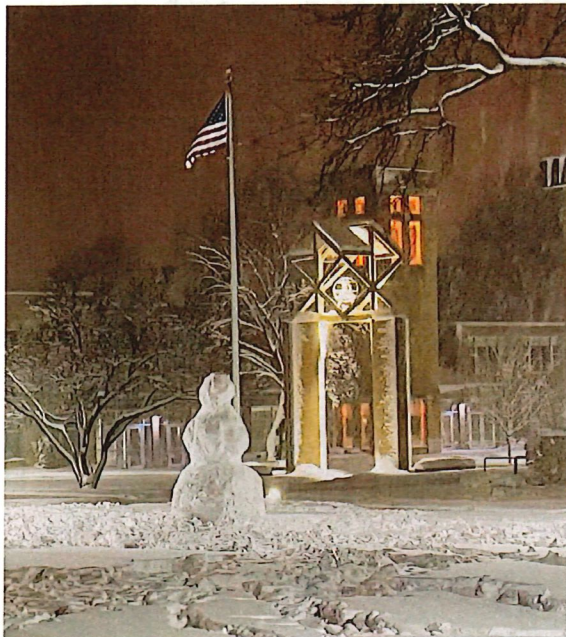
School Choice Open Enrollment
