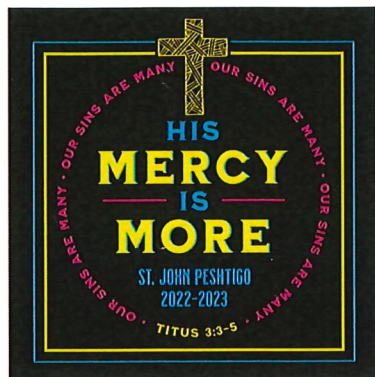
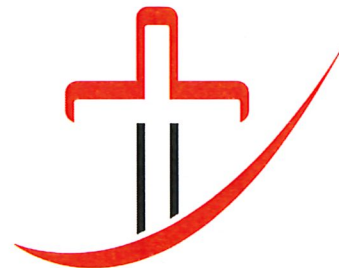

School Choice Update

The open enrollment to apply for the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program begins **today, Wednesday, February 1** and goes through Thursday, April 20. Students who are currently enrolled in the program or are on the waitlist **must reapply** for the 2023-24 school year. Students at St. John who are currently **NOT** enrolled in school choice **can apply** for the 2023-24 school year **if they are currently in 4K or Kindergarten** (entering K or 1st grade for the 23-24 school year). Parents intending to apply for the 2023-24 school year need to go to the WI Department of Public Instruction (DPI) web page in order to complete an application.
