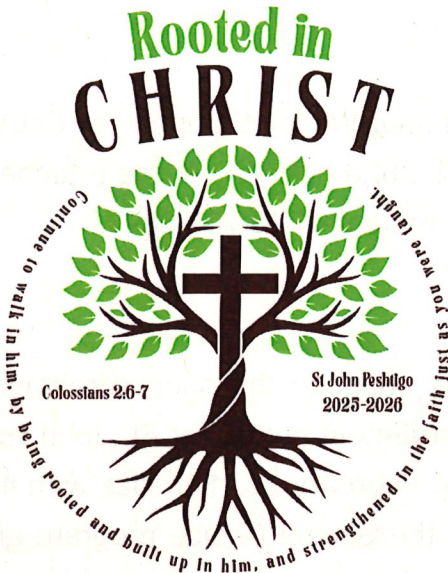

Call to Order:

1. Opening Prayer – Mr. Aguilar
2. Approval of Previous Minutes - Mr. Aguilar/ Cody 1st motion/ Cassie 2nd
3. Treasurer Update - Cody
3 transactions since Oct, all r/t the Kwik Trip fundraiser; \$11,009.26 net balance
4. New Business:
 - a. Pizza Fundraiser - Emily
Motion to postpone pizza sales until next school year – too close to upcoming fundraisers; need adequate time to prepare as we will not be relying upon assistance from Pizza Pros rep and should utilize manpower towards playground. KwikTrip fundraiser date moved up to Labor Day d/t improved profit margin offered in Sept; plan for pizza sales in Oct. Need a sign-up in advance so all can plan accordingly; if insufficient help is available, may defer the fundraiser altogether; can also consider Zion Lutheran youth group assistance. Jen s/w a pizza shop rep in FDL who may be willing to assist with ingredients, etc; will explore.

b. Playground install – open discussion

Location: north of existing playground. Engineer w/school planning can sketch layout; include the proposed bldg. addition, space for a new B-ball court area, then the 50' x 58' footprint for the new playground equip. Zipline is a separate 15' x 10' space. Must factor in the required 6' circumferential perimeter around ea “pod” of equip in order to meet code. Climber may not be assembled this summer d/t complexity and time constraints.

Given the landscape w/natural downward slope to the north, in effort to curtail hauling fill, will split equip't into 2 or 3 pods. Need to fence off the workspace for safety & notify Little League teams the playground is unavailable for their use during construction.

Plan to begin work at end of current school yr, namely on w/e. The “grounds cmte” of Jesse, Jeremy, Austin, Mike, and Cody will coordinate materials and equipment w/plans

to lay out posts for painting in Mar/Apr; Jen or Jesse will d/w Cory Karban for an estimate. Need to mark distal end of posts for assembly purposes. Austin has 18" auger and skidsteer; Mike and Cody have access to cement mixer (unclear size, ? 1/3 yd); Jesse can s/w his employer if add'l equip needs arise. Need est on amt of concrete needed for footings (46 posts, 24" deep, 18" wide); may need to consider Gillett Cement; will f/u with Mike this spring. Tentative plan: drill holes, lay out & assemble equip't, place upright, then pour concrete all at once – defer planning details to Grounds Cmte. Add'l volunteers requested for set up. Emily, Becky, Jen volunteered to make lunch. Copies of playground equip't map distributed by Jen and Becky.

Playground base options: 1) stone/ pea gravel: ? expense; also c/f stones making their way inside school, 2) rubber mulch; most likely the most expensive option, defer further exploration, or 3) cedar woodchips; Jen already s/w Tom Wiedemeier; he is willing to provide a discount but needs playground dimensions. Note: mulch must be 1' deep.

c. Seroogy's Candybars: anticipating sales mid-Feb; Hanna and Emily will clarify w/Lisa Sargent Re: timeline, order submission, delivery dates. Need 2 wk turnaround from pmt to order p/u from Seroogy's. Jen or Hanna volunteered to pick orders up in DP once ready for delivery. List of volunteers for order distribution noted. Recc incorporating updated fundraising efforts into the letter going out to families next week, as now proceeds will be directed towards materials for playgrounds set-up (e.g. concrete, paint, mulch). Recc hanging signage & photo prints of the assembled equip. at family night event.

d. PTO Social: Suggestion made to have a ribbon-cutting ceremony & picnic here once playground equip't is set. Further plans / discussion to come.
