Dear St. John Lutheran School families,

As we come to the last day of school in 2023, I would like to give thanks and glory to God for blessing us with a successful school year. Our summer break is only a few days away. It will be a time for rest and relaxation for our students. The Board of Education and the faculty, however, will be implementing a number of new items during the break. This letter is meant to inform you of these actions.

- Pastor Sargent will step down as Acting Principal. Mr. Aguilar has finished his two-year Principal Training Course and will take over as Principal.
